

















What is AVID?



- A fun, hands-on, college preparatory class.
- Meant to assist students in all of their core classes & eventually their freshman year of college or first year in the workfield.
 - > Students monitor their grades and reflect on their learning in other classes.
 - Students present questions they have from other classes; fellow students and tutors help them arrive at the correct answer (TRFs).
 - Students are helped as they navigate high school and guided in the college application process!
- AVID is an 8th-12th grade class taken during the school day!
 - > AVID elective students visit colleges throughout year, research their future, and host guest speakers to explore more careers.







AVID Strategies



- Students present a genuine question they have from another class.
- As a class, with the help of tutors, the student solves the problem!

Collaborative Study Groups

- Meant to look like high school or college study groups
- Students in the same class work together on assignments

Socratic Seminar

Students read an article or watch a video & discuss in detail their opinions and thoughts.

Philosophical Chairs

- Students research controversial topics, pick a side, and debate!
- SO MANY MORE!!! All are meant to help with your high school classes and eventually your plan after high school.








AVID Schedule

- If selected, AVID is a full year course from 8th-12th grade with the same students!!








